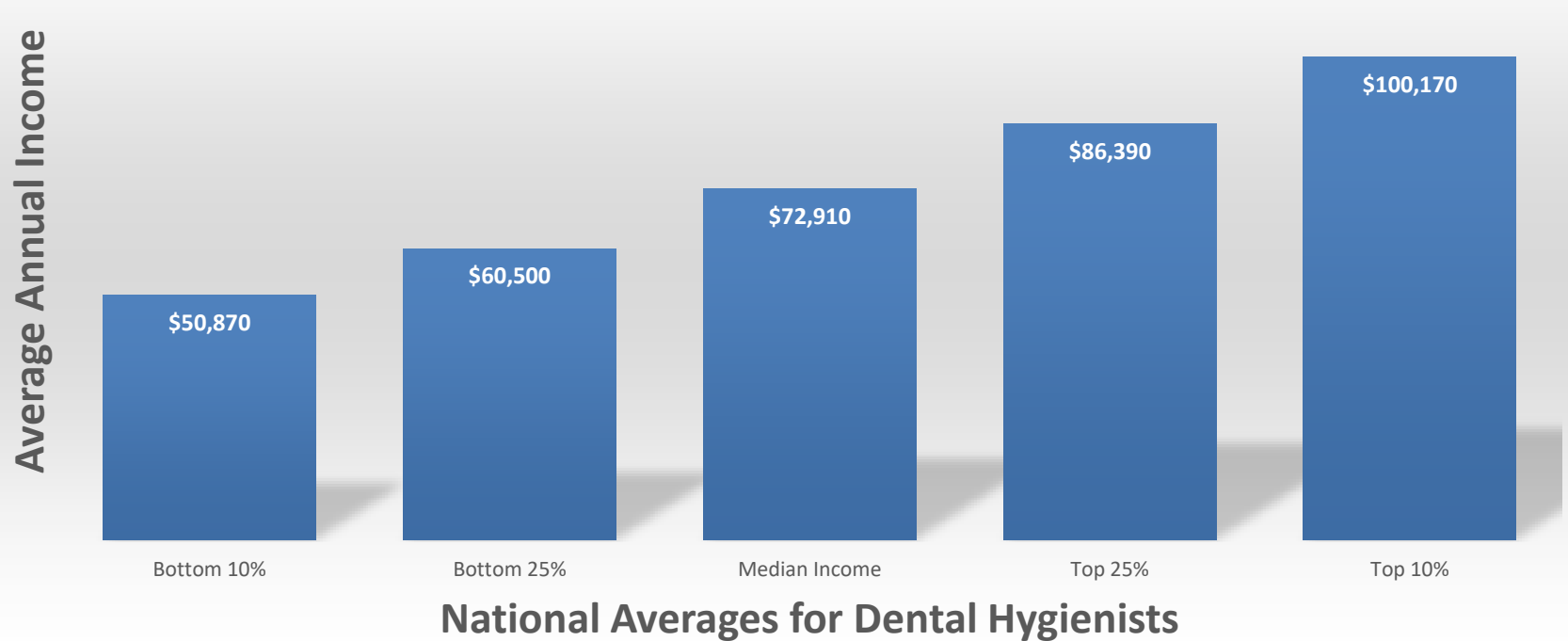


# Dental Hygienists

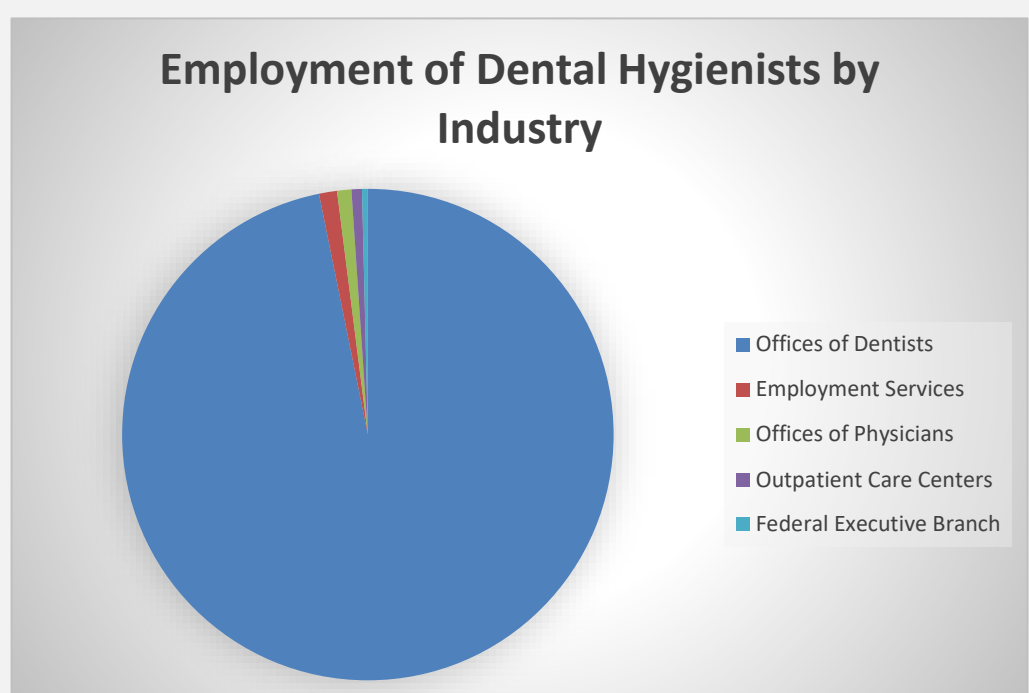

## Dental Hygienist: National Income Averages

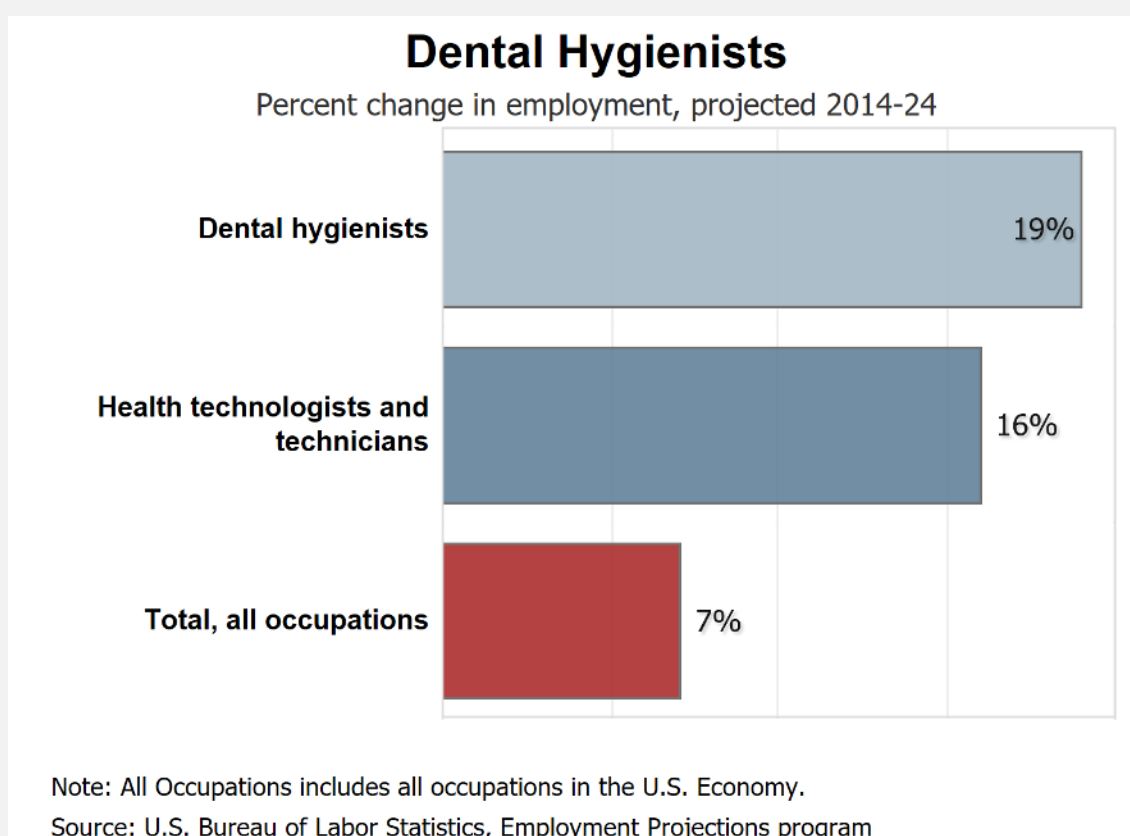


Dental Hygienists held approximately 200,800 jobs as of May 2016 according to the latest BLS data available.

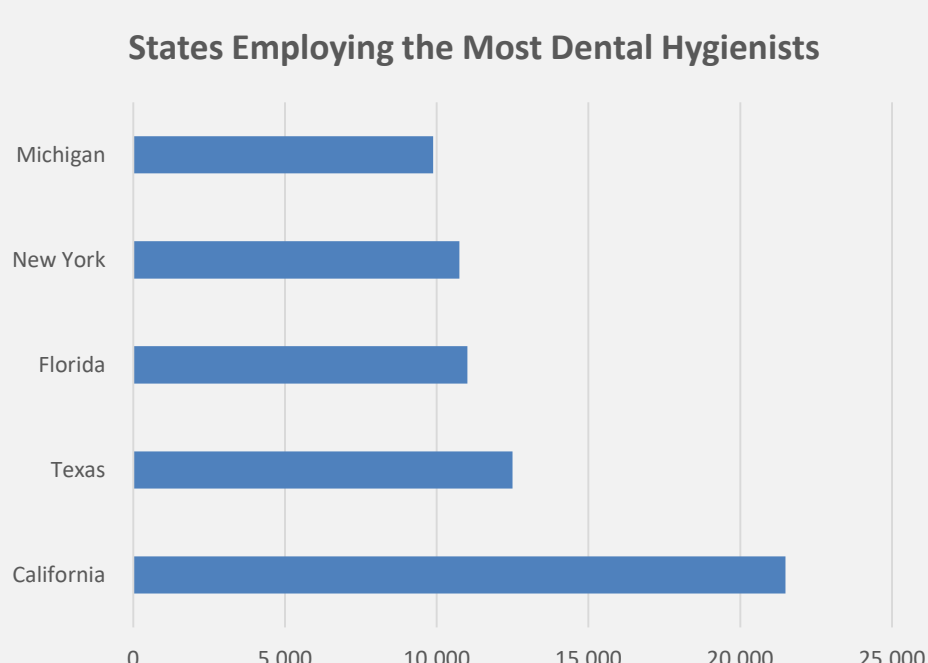
## Employment Changes Projected for Dental Hygienists

## States With the Highest Employment Levels for Dental Hygienists



The Bureau of Labor Statistics projects a workforce demand of 237,900 Dental Hygienists by 2024 compared to 200,500 today. The substantive growth in the dental profession is projected to **grow at rate of 19%** compared to all other occupations during that same timeframe.
